Prior to the start of the meeting, Mayor Dake asked everyone to continue to pray for Council member Ann Miller's nearly six month old granddaughter as she recently had major surgery. Mayor Dake also asked everyone to keep Police Officer Daniel Padgett in their thoughts as he was involved in an accident on Blue Grass Parkway today and was transported to the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

ROLL CALL:

MAYOR LAURA DAKE PRESIDED OVER THE MEETING. ALSO PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMBERS CHANTEL BINGHAM, MARY BRADLEY, LISA JOHNSON, GARY JONES, ANN MILLER, AND FRED SIEGELMAN. CITY ATTORNEY BILL MOORE WAS ALSO PRESENT.

DEPT. HEADS:

BART MILLER, T.A. RANKIN, ELIZABETH REYNOLDS, AND ROB YOUNG WERE PRESENT REPRESENTING THEIR RESPECTIVE

DEPARTMENTS.

MOTION BY SIEGELMAN, SECONDED BY BRADLEY TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE MINUTES OF THE JULY 15, 2025 REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING.

The vote was as follows: Bingham, Bradley, Johnson, Jones, Miller, and Siegelman voting aye.

Public Comment

No public comment was received.

Woodford County School Board Chair Adam Brickler introduced recently hired Superintendent Dr. Lori Jones to the council. Dr. Jones stated that she is excited to serve Woodford County Public Schools and mentioned several partnerships with the City including the Fire Science Program and partnering with the Versailles Police Department to ensure safety and meet traffic needs around school drop off and pick up. Dr. Jones noted that she is very thankful to be here in this community.

Nathan Lauderdale, Post Commander of American Legion Post 67, was present to recognize Cemetery Superintendent David Brinegar. Mr. Lauderdale stated that he Mr. Brinegar had gone above and beyond to repair veterans markers in the cemetery. Mr. Lauderdale and Post Adjunct Howard White presented Mr. Brinegar with a certificate of appreciation and a challenge coin.

Mr. Brinegar thanked them for the recognition and stated that he is proud to work for the City of Versailles.

At the request of Council member Siegelman, City Attorney Bill Moore provided first reading of Ordinance 2025-15 An Ordinance Amending Section 97.03 of the Versailles Code of Ordinances to Specifically Include the Responsibility for Managing Trees, Shrubs, and Other Vegetation with the Responsibilities of the Owner or Occupant of Property Next to Any Street or Alley.

Mayor Dake stated that some issues had recently occurred that showed that we needed to clarify the ordinances, specifically regarding who maintains the trees. Council member Miller suggested that the ordinance should say owner and not occupant, as a tenant would not be responsible. She also suggested changing the section of the ordinance that references "to the middle of the street" noting that property owners are only expected to maintain to the edge. Ms. Miller also noted a few other minor changes.

The Council, Mayor Dake, and City Attorney Bill Moore discussed the changes and agreed to make the changes as noted and present for first reading again at the next meeting.

Public Works Director Bart Miller presented the following quote for Huntertown Water Tank Mural Painting:

Mr. Miller stated that Mr. Henn was the original artist that painted the horse mural on the water tank in 2003. Mr. Miller noted that since it is an artistic work, it is a sole source quote. In addition to the labor and paint, the City is responsible for providing tan 80 foot articulated boom lift and lodging for the artist for the duration of the work which is expected to take 30-35 days.

MOTION BY SIEGELMAN, SECONDED BY JOHNSON TO APPROVE AND ACCPT THE QUOTE AS PRESENTED BY ERIC HENN FOR THE HUNTERTOWN WATER TANK MURAL PAINTING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$85,000 FOR LABOR, PAINT, AND CLEARCOAT, IN ADDITION TO THE TOTAL COST OF PROVIDING AN 80' ARTICULATED BOOM LIFT, AND THE TOTAL COST OF PROVIDING LODGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT.

The vote was as follows: Bingham, Bradley, Johnson, Jones, Miller, and Siegelman voting ave.

Mayor Dake presented a Neighborhood Grant Application for Merewood Subvision in the amount of \$2,500 for trees and landscaping the main entrance.

MOTION BY MILLER, SECONDED BY BINGHAM TO APPROVE THE NEIGHBORHOOD GRANT APPLICATION FOR MEREWOOD SUBDIVISION IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$2,500 FOR TREES AND LANDSCAPTING FOR THE MAIN ENTRANCE.

The vote was as follows: Bingham, Bradley, Johnson, Jones, Miller, and Siegelman voting aye.

City Clerk Elizabeth Reynolds stated that at the previous council meeting a utility adjustment for 181 Gleneagles Way was inadvertently presented for the wrong amount. The total amount should have been \$323.49 but only an adjustment of \$210.20 was approved. She asked the council to approve the additional adjustment of \$113.29.

MOTION BY SIEGELMAN, SECONDED BY BRADLEY TO APPROVE THE UTILITY ADJUSTMENT FOR 181 GLENEAGLES WAY IN THE ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$113.29.

The vote was as follows: Bingham, Bradley, Johnson, Jones, Miller, and Siegelman voting aye.

Mayor Miscellaneous

Mayor Dake stated that Market Days will be held at The District on Saturday, August 9th 8:30am – 12:00pm. She noted that there would be a breakfast food truck there and \$10 vouchers will be given out to children to use at any of the Market Days vendors.

She also stated that the Splash of Summer will be held on Saturday at The District and Big Spring Park in partnership with the Versailles Parks & Recreation Department. There will be bounce houses, crafts, water events, and food trucks. The event will be $12:00 \, \text{pm} - 7:00 \, \text{pm}$ and is for kids of all ages.

Mayor Dake congratulated Council member Lisa Johnson on achieving her Level III Master of City Governance through the Kentucky League of Cities.

She distributed Executive Order 2025-03 dated July 24, 2025, creating a Walkability Committee.

Council Miscellaneous/Committee Reports

Council member Johnson, as the Executive Director of Mentors and Meals, invited everyone to participate in the 2025 Team Trivia Night fundraiser. She stated that the City has a complimentary table for the event, which will be held on August 28th, if any of the council members would like to attend.

Department Directors

Mr. Miller stated that the Twilight Festival will be held September 6th 12:00pm - 9:00pm.

CITY OF VERSAILLES ORDINANCE NO. 2025-15

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 97.03 OF THE VERSAILLES CODE OF ORDINANCES TO SPECIFICALLY INCLUDE THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR MANAGING TREES, SHRUBS AND OTHER VEGETATION WITH THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE OWNER OF PROPERTY NEXT TO ANY STREET OR ALLEY AND TO SPECIFY THAT THE PROPERTY OWNER, RATHER THAN THE OCCUPANT, HAS SUCH RESPONSIBILITIES, AND TO REMOVE ANY RESPONSIBILITY TO MAINTAIN CITY STREETS, ALLEYS AND THEIR GUTTERS.

Whereas, the City desires to amend Section 97.03 of the City's Code of Ordinances to clarify that it is the responsibility of all persons owning property adjoining any street or alley within the City to manage and maintain all trees, shrubs and other vegetation between the owner's property and the street or alley and to remove such responsibility from the occupant of the property, and to further remove any responsibility for a property owner to maintain the City streets and alleys or their gutters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED IN THE CITY OF VERSAILLES, KENTUCKY as follows:

Section 1. Section 97.03 of the Versailles Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§ 97.03 DUTIES OF ADJACENT OWNERS.

The occupant, or if none, the owner of every lot or building adjoining any street or alley shall keep the half of his street or alley their property, including the sidewalks and gutters adjoining such property, well cleaned and free from obstructions, and the owner shall keep the adjoining sidewalk and gutter-in good repair. This responsibility includes the duty to

maintain all trees, shrubs and other vegetation to the gutter or street in a manner that does not obstruct the vision of persons using the street or alley and that does not otherwise present a danger to the public. This duty specifically includes the duty to remove any tree, shrub or vegetation that presents a danger to persons using the street or alley. The City Council may by municipal order create a program for sidewalk construction and maintenance as funding in the General Fund budget allows.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective after passage and publication as required by law.

CITY OF VERSAILLES, KENTUCKY RESOLUTION NO. 2025-9

TITLE: A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS, WATER TAPS AND SEWER TAPS FOR UNIT 5 OF THE LEGENDS AT VERSAILLES SUBDIVISION, THE SPRINGS OF VERSAILLES SUBDIVISION, AND ANY OTHER SUBDIVISION CONSISTING OF MORE THAN FOUR LOTS LOCATED ON A STREET IN A SUBDIVISION WHERE THE APPROVED PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT PLAN SHOWS CONNECTIVITY WITH EXISTING STREETS IN ADJOINING NEIGHBORHOODS AND SUCH CONNECTIONS HAVE NOT YET OCCURRED.

Whereas, the developer of the Legends at Versailles Subdivision has recently informed the City that the developer has no intention of connecting the portion of Edmonds Crossing located within that subdivision to the portion of Edmonds Crossing located within the adjoining Edmonds Cross subdivision; and

Whereas, the zone change for the Legends at Versailles Subdivision as a planned unit development was approved in part based upon a Preliminary Development Plan that showed the extension of Edmonds Crossing from the Edmonds Cross Subdivision through what is now the Legends at Versailles Subdivision to South Main Street; and

Whereas, each of the succeeding seven Amended Preliminary Development Plans for the subdivision now known as the Legends at Versailles showed the extension of Edmonds Crossing from the Edmonds Cross Subdivision through the subdivision to South Main Street; and

Whereas, the design standards for subdivisions in Versailles require that street systems be designed for a smooth flow of traffic and a high level of connectivity within and between neighborhoods (Article 6, Section 620(A)(2); and

Whereas, the Comprehensive Plan directs that new developments should be interconnected with existing developed areas and allow for interconnection with adjacent undeveloped areas in order to provide alternative means of ingress and egress as well as to allow efficient means of providing public services; and

Whereas, the developer of the Legends at Versailles Subdivision has not posted any bond for construction of the portion of Edmonds Crossing that would pass through the final section or unit of the subdivision and connect with portion of said street located in the Edmonds Cross Subdivision; and

The developer of the Legends at Versailles Subdivision or persons affiliated with said developer have submitted a preliminary development plan for a new subdivision

called Springs of Versailles Subdivision with the zone change request recently approved by the City for that Subdivision; and

Whereas, the preliminary development plan for the Springs of Versailles Subdivision also provides for connectivity to existing streets within the adjoining Adena Woods Subdivision and with Falling Springs Boulevard; and

Whereas, the City is concerned about its present ability to enforce developers' representations of their intention to complete development plans which provide for connectivity of streets in newly platted subdivisions with existing streets; and

Whereas, the local Planning Commission has recently commissioned Blueprint Kentucky to perform a housing study to determine the housing needs of this community for inclusion in a new Chapter of the Comprehensive Plan Update; and

Whereas, the City has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to suspend development in Unit 5 of the Legends Subdivision and the Springs of Versailles Subdivision, and all other developments which provide for connectivity with existing public streets where such connectivity has not occurred and there is no mechanism in place to compel the completion of such connectivity.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Versailles, Kentucky as follows:

- 1. Pending posting with the City of a certificate of deposit in the amount sufficient to guarantee completion of Edmonds Crossing through the Legends at Versailles Subdivision to the Edmonds Cross Subdivision as shown on the Preliminary Development Plans of the Legends at Versailles Subdivision, there shall be a moratorium on the issuance of all building permits, water taps and sewer taps for the lots of Unit 5 of the Legends at Versailles Subdivision and any subsection of such Unit.
- 2. Pending the completion of the housing study to be conducted by Blueprint Kentucky and the amendment of the Subdivision regulations in a manner to provide the City with a mechanism to enforce representations of connectivity shown on preliminary subdivision plans by developers, there shall be a moratorium on the issuance of building permits, water taps and sewer taps for the lots in the Springs at Versailles Subdivision and all other subdivisions consisting of more than four lots located on street shown on an approved preliminary development plan showing connectivity of such street with existing City streets and such connections have not yet occurred or been fully bonded.
- 3. The moratorium created by this Resolution shall be temporary in nature and reviewed by the City Council no later than six months after its adoption to review its effects.

- 4. In the meantime, the City Council requests that Woodford County Property Valuation Administer assess Unit 5 of the Legends Subdivision at the full fair cash value of the residential lots shown on the approved Preliminary Development Plan of the subdivision, and that the City's Abandoned and Blighted Properties Commission review the situation created by the developer's decision to abandon the remainder of the Legends of Versailles Subdivision and determine whether the lots within that Unit should be classified as abandoned urban property for purposes of ad valorem taxation.
- 5. The City Council further requests that the Mayor consider forming a committee to study the possible use of Unit 5 of the Legends at Versailles Subdivision as a means to provide affordable housing in the community.

PRIME AE Group, Inc. (PRIME AE) is pleased to formally submit our proposal for the City of Versailles Safe Streets and Roads for All Demonstration Project. This proposal includes a detailed fee structure, outlining the scope of services we anticipate for the successful completion of this project. For your reference, a map highlighting the key study locations is provided as **Exhibit A**, attached to this proposal. We are excited about the opportunity to collaborate with the City of Versailles and look forward to the opportunity to work closely with the city to achieve the project goals.

Scope of Sawless

Woodford Plaza Vehicle Access

Data Collection / Demonstration Equipment Implementation

\$14,500

PRIME AE proposes to collect vehicular traffic counts at four key intersections around the Woodford Plaza Shopping Center: the main entrance off US 60 / Lexington St., the Wendy's entrance off US 60 / Lexington St., the primary entrance off Wilson Avenue, and the Wilson Avenue - US 60 / Lexington St. intersection. Traffic counts will be conducted over four days, including two weekdays and the weekend, to ensure representative data. The counts will span 13 hours each day, capturing peak AM and PM traffic hours. Data will be collected three times: before, during, and after the project demonstration implementation. Our data collection effort will also include a qualitative road safety audit (RSA).

The scope of work also includes the purchase, installation, and monitoring of equipment during demonstration implementation. This work may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Install approximately 200 linear feet (LF) of Qwick Kurb along Lexington Street stretching from the US 60 interchange to Wilson Avenue to prevent left turn movements off US 60 into the Woodford Plaza.
- Install approximately 100 LF of temporary water filled plastic jersey barriers across the western Woodford Plaza entrance to delineate a pedestrian crosswalk, prevent right-turns in at this location, and channelize entering and exiting traffic into a RT-in/RT-out entrance at the eastern access point.

 Install appropriate signing and temporary pavement striping (tape) as required to serve as wayfinding for pedestrians and vehicles at this location.

Woodford Plaza Pedestrian Route

Data Collection / Demonstration Equipment Implementation

\$14,500

PRIME AE proposes to collect pedestrian counts at the same four key intersections around the Woodford Plaza Shopping Center: the main entrance off US 60 / Lexington St., the Wendy's entrance off US 60 / Lexington St., the primary entrance off Wilson Avenue, and the Wilson Avenue - US 60 / Lexington St. intersection. These pedestrian counts will be conducted simultaneously with the vehicular traffic counts, using the same days, hours, and timeframes to ensure consistency between the two datasets.

The scope of work also includes the purchase, installation, and monitoring of equipment during demonstration implementation. This work may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Install approximately 275 LF of water filled jersey barriers or equivalent channelizing device stretching west along Wilson Avenue from the Woodford Plaza entrance. The project team may elect to install less intrusive devices such paint or tape following a field review.
- Install an approximately 50 LF striped crosswalk parallel with Wilson Avenue across the Woodford Plaza entrance using temporary paint or tape.
- Install approximately 270 LF of temporary paint or tape to delineate a pedestrian walkway through the Woodford Plaza parking lot. The project team may elect to provide multiple pedestrian walkways to monitor usage and/or use as a comparison.
- Install additional signing as required to serve as wayfinding for pedestrians and vehicles at this location.

Laval Heights / Lexington Road Access Road

Data Collection / Demonstration Equipment Implementation

\$8,000

PRIME AE proposes to collect vehicular traffic counts at the Laval Heights and Equestrian Way / Daisy Hill Drive intersections with US 60 / Lexington St. The selection of these locations is based on their proximity to the proposed changes and their potential to experience altered traffic patterns as a result of the left-turn restriction out of Laval Heights.

PRIME AE plans to evaluate traffic patterns at these two intersections before, during, and after the implementation of the demonstration project. We propose conducting 8-hour traffic counts on one representative weekday, capturing peak AM and PM traffic hours to ensure comprehensive data collection. In addition to the traffic counts, PRIME AE also recommends conducting a near-miss crash analysis at the Laval Heights-Lexington St. intersection



prior to the project's implementation. This analysis will help establish a baseline safety threshold for comparison. An additional data collection effort will also include a qualitative road safety audit (RSA).

The scope of work also includes the purchase, installation, and monitoring of equipment during demonstration implementation. This work may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Install cones, traffic barrels, or equivalent channelizing devices along Laval Heights at the intersection with US 60 / Lexington St. to prevent left-turn movements off Laval Heights onto US 60.
- Install appropriate signing and temporary pavement striping as required to alert drivers of change in traffic pattern.

Midway Road Speed Radar

Data Collection \$3,000

PRIME AE proposes to collect vehicular tube counts at a selected location along US 62 between Versailles and Midway. These counts will capture spot speed data, vehicular traffic volume, and truck classification data. PRIME AE recommends using tube counts instead of digital speed awareness signs to more accurately establish baseline speeds along this high-speed corridor.

Public Outreach / Involvement

GIS Storyboard Creation / Flyer Distribution / Stakeholder Meetings

\$25,000

For public outreach, PRIME AE proposes to develop an interactive and easily accessible GIS storyboard to encourage public engagement, education, and feedback about various aspects of the project. This online storyboard will be available for viewing on the City of Versailles website, allowing the public to explore the project details at their convenience. Additionally, PRIME AE plans to create informational flyers featuring QR codes that will direct the public to the GIS storyboard, making it simple for individuals to access and participate. PRIME AE also anticipates organizing stakeholder meetings and is eager to collaborate with the City of Versailles to identify the most effective methods for facilitating public engagement.

Planning / Process Data / Write Report

Report / Data Presentation / Recommendations / Discussion of Safety Strategies

\$28,500

PRIME AE will compile our findings into a comprehensive written report that adheres to the U.S. DOT Safe Streets and Roads for All planning grant guidelines. The report will present detailed traffic and pedestrian count data, crash data, traffic capacity information, alternative pedestrian and vehicular accommodation recommendations, and targeted study area safety mitigation strategies. To assess the impact of the proposed designs on traffic and pedestrian flow, PRIME AE will develop and analyze baseline traffic capacity models as needed. These models may include intersection and corridor capacity analyses, turning lane warrants, turn lane length calculations, and existing



and alternative design scenarios and comparisons. PRIME AE will work closely with the City of Versailles to customize the report to meet the city's specific preferences while ensuring full compliance with SS4ALL grant guidelines.

<u>Fee</u>

PRIME AE will perform the defined scope of services for a lump sum fee of \$93,500.

Exclusions

The following items are not included in our defined scope of services and would be billed as additional services if given written authorization to do so by the Client:

- Traffic Signal Warrant Analysis
- Creation of a traffic / pedestrian microsimulation model (i.e. PTV VISSIM or SIMTRAFFIC) of the project study area.
- Data Collection and analysis of additional existing intersections not defined in the scope of services.
- Any other item not specifically noted in the scope of services.
