MOTION BY BINGHAM, SECONDED BY BRADLEY TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL 1, 2025 REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING.

The vote was as follows: Bingham, Bradley, Jones, and Siegelman voting ave. Council members Johnson and Miller abstained.

MOTION BY SIEGELMAN, SECONDED BY BINGHAM TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL 8, 2025 SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING.

The vote was as follows: Bingham, Bradley, Johnson, Jones, and Siegelman voting aye. Council member Miller abstained.

Public Comment

No public comment was received.

Cassie Prather, Public Health Director of the Woodford County Health Department, provided the council with an update on funding of the local health department. Mrs. Prather stated that they had been affected by federal cuts including stop work orders on Immunization, COVID Response, and Communicable Disease Funding. She noted that they are statutorily required to provide certain things even if their federal funding is cut or stopped all together. Mrs. Prather stated that they are currently approximately \$100,000 short on their budget because they rely on state and federal funds to cover approximately 35% of their funding. She did note that they have reserves in the taxing district accounts and operating accounts.

Mrs. Prather further discussed the possibility of increasing the public health tax, currently \$0.020 per \$1,000 of property value, as it is currently lowest rate in the state and has not been increased since it was established. She noted that they have been in their building for twenty-five years and it is in need of repair. She also stated that they have a role in emergency preparedness and response, which included setting up mobile stations to provide TDAP vaccinations for those cleaning up after the recent floods.

City Attorney Moore asked how the public health tax rate is set. Mrs. Prather responded that the Health Department Board votes on recommending an increase to the Fiscal Court and then the Fiscal Court would have to approve it.

The Council thanked Mrs. Prather for the great work of the Woodford County Health Department.

MOTION BY MILLER, SECONDED BY BRADLEY TO APPROVE AND ADOPT RESOLUTION 2025-7 FISCAL YEAR 2026 MUNICIPAL ROAD AID.

Council member Bingham stated that the Street/Stormwater/Cemetery Committee had met but they also are not recommending any action at this time. She stated that they will be asking the council to approve painting some of the curbs yellow on Abbey Road but they want to discuss further before making a recommendation.

Council member Johnson invited everyone, especially women, to the American Association of University Women's Women in Government Panel to be held at Woodford County Library on Thursday, April 17th at 6:00pm. She noted that the panel will include Mayor Dake and State Senator Amanda Mays Bledsoe.

Council member Siegelman asked if the Street/Stormwater/Cemetery committee had discussed the issue on Bowmar Street related to a resident having trouble backing out of his driveway because of people parallel parking across the street from the driveway. Council member Bingham stated that they had discussed it but determined it was a civil manner and they were hopeful that it can be handled kindly between neighbors.

Department Directors

Public Works Director Miller stated that City Hall would be closed on Friday, April 18th in recognition of Good Friday.

City Clerk Reynolds played a video from LEX18 news which showed a recent interview with Utilities Manager Mitzi Delius regarding the flooding at the Versailles Water Treatment Plant.

Council member Bingham noted that flood relief donations of cleaning items can be dropped off at Simmons Elementary or at the WCHS baseball game on Wednesday night.

Public Works Director Miller stated that the City's public works department is working throughout Woodford County to remove debris from the recent flooding.

Fire Chief Rankin thanked everyone who attended the recent Station #1 Open House after the completion of building renovations.

Chief Rankin stated that the Versailles Fire Department had worked throughout Woodford and Anderson Counties, as part of mutual aid agreements, using the recently purchased boats. He noted that himself and his dad were among those that had to be rescued by boat at his dad's home on the Kentucky River. He also thanked Campbellsville Fire Department for their assistance since most surrounding departments were busy serving in their own areas.

Chief Rankin announced that the Versailles Fraternal Order of Firefighters are accepting monetary donations for flood relief.

Mayor Dake adjourned the meeting without objections.

TITLE: A MUNICIPAL ORDER UPDATING THE POSITION DESCRIPTION FOR 911 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR WITHIN THE VERSAILLES MIDWAY WOODFORD COUNTY 911 DEPARTMENT

Section 1. The following position description is adopted:

CITY OF VERSAILLES POSITION DESCRIPTION

Class Title: Executive Director

Department: Versailles Midway Woodford County 911

Supervisor: 911 Board

Supervises: Telecommunicators

<u>Class Characteristics</u>: Under general direction, plans, organizes, directs and coordinates the operations of the Versailles Midway Woodford County 911 Emergency Services and Central Telecommunications. In this document "911" and "E-911" shall include 911 services as well as Central Telecommunications.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

Essential:

- 1. Coordinates addressing of Woodford County for operation and maintenance of the E-911 emergency communication system.
- 2. Coordinates with the Woodford Fiscal Court, Versailles City Government and Midway City Government ongoing procedure by which continual updating/verification of moves, adds and changes to the existing address listing.
- 3. Coordinates with telephone companies, their officials, and other agencies concerning emergency response procedures (includes but not limited to the maintenance of a Master Street Address Guide (MSAG), (ESN).
- 4. Oversees audit of roads within Woodford County to insure that the addresses in the address listing is correct and matches the information provided by the telephone companies.
- 5. Attends meetings related to E-911 issues.
- 6. Submits reports to the 911 Board on issues relating to E-911.
- 7. Other related duties as assigned by the Chair of the 911 Board concerning the E-911 system.

- 8. Ability to work as telecommunicator as needed.
- 9. Supervises all telecommunicators including development and maintenance of schedule, annual evaluations, counseling, referral of disciplinary recommendations and any other related tasks.

Non-essential: None.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

<u>Training and Experience</u>: Graduation from high school or equivalent; with two to three years work experience preferred; must currently be a certified Telecommunicator and NCIC/LINK certified, or successfully obtain such certifications within one (1) year of being hired.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge:

- 1. Knowledge of, or ability to learn, public safety operating procedures.
- 2. Knowledge of, or ability to learn, communications systems.
- 3. Knowledge of, or ability to learn, the geography of the city and county, including the location of streets and roads, major buildings, etc.

Skills:

- 1. Skill in the use of radios/telephones
- 2. Organizational skills.
- 3. Communication skills.

Abilities:

- 1. Ability to do multiple duties simultaneously.
- 2. Ability to analyze complex situations and execute effective courses of action.
- 3. Ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing.
- 4. Ability to type; ability to operate computer terminal.
- 4. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with officers and employees of the city, personnel from other emergency units, and the general public.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

<u>Instructions</u>: Instructions are detailed and specific, covering all aspects of the work.

<u>Processes</u>: Must occasionally consider different courses of action, or deviate from standard operation procedures to get job done.

Review of Work: Unless major problems arise, work is not reviewed.

<u>Analytical Requirements</u>: Assignments frequently involve decisions based on a wide knowledge of many factors where application of advanced or technical concepts are required.

<u>Tools, Equipment and Vehicles Used</u>: Windows network computer system; E-911 system; radio, telephone, fax machine, typewriter, operate a motor vehicle.

<u>Physical Demands</u>: Work is performed indoors at a desk or table. Must lift objects weighing less than twenty-five pounds. Must use telephone, normal office equipment (computer, copier, etc.) and operate a motor vehicle.

<u>Contacts</u>: Frequent public and internal contacts requiring tact and diplomacy are requirements of the job.

<u>Confidential Information</u>: Regular use of confidential information is a job requirement.

Mental Effort: Moderate.

Interruptions: Few.

<u>Special Licensing Requirements</u>: Must possess and maintain valid driver's license issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

<u>Availability</u>: Normal business hours and may be needed in emergency situations and/or if problems arise with the E-911 system.

Additional Requirements: None.

Overtime Provision: Exempt.




